**Holy Week 2008**

The churches of Lake City provided a rich offering of Holy Week services this year. Community Presbyterian offered Maundy Thursday and Good Friday services in the evening, while St. James Episcopal provided a noon Good Friday service. St. Rose Catholic Church offered a Stations of the Cross service on Good Friday afternoon.

Grace Fellowship and St. James Episcopal held early Easter morning Communion services. A community breakfast was provided by all of the churches in the First Baptist Fellowship Hall on Easter morning, and all of the Lake City churches provided leadership for the Community Easter Service in the Armory. Lyn Lampert of Grace Fellowship preached the sermon, "Hope and the Resurrection." The Lake City Community Choir and the Grace Fellowship Praise Team provided special music. A separate worship experience was offered to older children while their parents worshiped in the Armory. St. Rose Catholic Church offered an Easter Mass that afternoon. Holy Week worship services in Lake City demonstrate the unity of all followers of Christ, under his guidance and authority.

**Youth Programs (.epic.) Update**

All of the youth of Lake City continue to meet several times weekly under the able leadership of Crystal and Seth Dady. (The youth have chosen the name .epic. for their group and their programs.) The high school and middle school students meet together on Sunday nights in the CPC Annex for fellowship and devotionals. High school boys and girls meet separately on Monday nights for Bible study in the Annex and Darley Hall. The high school and middle school youth alternate Wednesdays meeting at the home of one of the young people for snacks, fellowship, and discussion. The CPC Annex has become the principal meeting place for the youth, and the Dady's have established their office upstairs. We are thrilled that the space can be used in this way!

Seth and Crystal are working diligently to plan an early June mission trip to Juarez, Mexico for the high school students, to build a house for a family in need and to share the Gospel however the situation may arise.
